ACTIVITY: ANIMAL VERSE SEARCH

WHAT YOU NEED: SEVERAL PLUSH ANIMALS

WHAT YOU DO:

Place the plush friends around the room. Call out an animal. When your child spots it, lead them over to say the verse to that plush friend. Return to the activity area and call out another animal. Repeat until you've traveled and said the verse to each plush friend.

WHAT YOU SAY:

Do you see our plush friends around the room? Do you see an animal near you?

Good job! Let's go over and say our memory verse to the [animal's name].

God (point up) saw everything he had made. (Binocular hands, look around) And it was very good, (thumbs-up) Genesis 1:31. (Open hands like a book.)

That was fun! Great job! God made everything. That includes ALL the animals and every single one of you!

Who made everything? God made everything.”



ACTIVITY: BIBLE STORY REVIEW

WHAT YOU NEED: BIBLE, READ GENESIS 1:31

WHAT YOU SAY:

In this weeks Bible story, God finished all His work. He had made the whole world and everything in it: light and dark; sky and water; land, plants, and sea; sun, moon, and stars; birds and fish; land animals and people! God made everything! Who made everything? God made everything!

Then He rested, looked at all that He had made, and said it was very good, just like it says in the Bible verse we've been learning. 'God saw everything he had made, and it was very good,' Genesis 1:31.

Let's stand up and say that together with the motions,

God (point up) saw everything he had made, (binocular hands, look around) and it was very good, (thumbs-up) Genesis 1:31." (Open hands like a book.)

It sounds like you're ready! (Give two thumbs-up.) Now you can sit down. If you want to say it alone, give it a try.

Okay, when I count to three, I want you to stand up and shout the verse. One, two, three!

Great job! Today, let's make a list of our favorite things that God made. There's a lot to choose from! It can be anything in the whole, wide world because [Bottom Line] God made everything!

God is SO amazing! Now we're ready to pray. Would you like to pray before I pray?"

(Give your child pray the opportunity to do so.)

Dear God, You are SO awesome! You made the whole world and everything in it! And it is all so very good! Thank You for making us. These are some of our favorite things that You made. Help us stop, rest, and look at the wonderful world You made for us to live in. We love You, God. In Jesus' name, amen
