ACTIVITY: HELPING CHARADES

WHAT YOU NEED: NO SUPPLIES WHAT YOU SAY:

WHAT YOU DO:

Watch video) Let's sit down and talk about today's Bible story. One, two, three, sit down with me!

The Bible story was about how King David wanted to find someone from Jonathan's family who he could help. He wanted to show kindness to them.

Who did King David find? He found Jonathan's son, Mephibosheth.

God made us to help others, too. When we help others, like King David helped Mephibosheth, we are doing a big thing. The Bible verse we're learning will help us remember to be strong and courageous so we can do what it takes to help others. It says . . . 'Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid . . . for the Lord your God goes with you,' Deuteronomy 31:6.

David helped Mephibosheth in our story today. There are lots of people we can help, too. That's why we're going to make a list of people we can help. I want you to think about the people in your house, your neighborhood, your school, and here at church. Tell me people that you can help, and I will write them in our down.
