ACTIVITY: WHO CAN TRUST GOD CATCH

WHAT YOU NEED: BEACH BALL OR SOFT FOAM BALL

WHAT YOU DO:

To Play:

Say "[Child's name] can trust God" and throw the ball to your child. Encourage your child to catch the ball then throw it back and say, "I can trust God."

Say:
I have a game for us to play today. I'll say your name, then I'll say, 'Can trust God.' Then I will throw you the ball. You'll catch it then throw it back to me and say, 'I can trust God.' Ready?"

[Child's name] can trust God. Good catch! Throw it back to me and say 'I can trust God.' (Pause.) Awesome! Let's keep going. (Repeat as many times as desired.)

No matter where we are, how we feel, or what we're doing, God will always love us. We can always trust God because nothing can ever separate us from His love. Who can trust God? I can trust God.



ACTIVITY: SEPARATE

WHAT YOU NEED: HULA HOOP; OPTIONAL FLOOR TAPE

WHAT YOU DO:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY:

Place the hula hoop in the activity area.

Option: If needed, tape a large enough circle on the floor to provide room for social distancing and forgo the hula hoop.

DURING THE ACTIVITY:

Ask your child/children to stand in the hula hoop together. Then ask them to step out of the hula hoop and go their separate ways. Repeat several times.

WHAT YOU SAY:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY:

Say:

Hey, friends! Do you see the circle on the floor? (Pause.) Let's all stand inside the circle!"

DURING THE ACTIVITY:

Great job! We're all together! Now, let's separate! Everyone, go a separate way! (Do activity.)

AFTER THE ACTIVITY:

Great job, friends. We were all together, then we separated! Today in our Bible story, we'll hear about something that we can NEVER separate from.

PRAYER

Dear God, thank You that nothing will ever separate us from Your love. Help us to remember how much You love us so we will always trust You. We love You, God. In Jesus' name, amen.
