ACTIVITY: MEMORY VERSE

WHAT YOU NEED: NO MATERIALS NEEDED

WHAT YOU DO:

(Say the memory verse and do the following motions in front of your child.)

WHAT YOU SAY:

I will say our new memory verse. Be sure you watch me!

God (point up) saw everything he had made. (Binocular hands, look around) And it was very good,” (thumbs-up) Genesis 1:31. (Open hands like a book.)

(Say the verse again with the motions and invite your child to do it with you. Repeat several times.)

Now, let's do it together! Are you ready?

Our memory verse tells us that God made everything! We are fearfully and wonderfully made. Who made everything? God made everything!



ACTIVITY: NAME IT

WHAT YOU NEED: NO MATERIALS NEEDED

WHAT YOU DO:

Name two animals and then guide your child to vote for the one they think is more powerful. They vote by pantomiming that animal's movements.

Possible combos include:

1. kitten or polar bear
2. lion or mouse
3. whale and goldfish
4. snail or shark
5. elephant or worm
6. turtle or T-Rex

If possible, include your Childs' favorite animals as choices. You can even invite your child to name two animals!

As the your child pantomimes, make comments like: Wow! I see a lot of whales swimming around! Whoa! One just jumped out of the water,” or “Look at those elephants lumber around the room and swing their trunks!

WHAT YOU SAY:

Animals can be SO powerful! Elephants can knock down trees. Lions can leap and catch their prey. Whales can breach and leap out of the water. In your lesson, you heard about SOMEONE who's more powerful than ANYTHING! Who is that?

That's right, God is more powerful than anything other than anyone!

Dear God, You are amazing and SO powerful! You made EVERYTHING! Today, we want to thank You for making light so we can see and the dark to help us sleep. Thank You for making water for us to drink and the great, big, beautiful sky. You made the sky SO big that we can see things like (read the list the children made) floating and flying in it!
